

Filming on Highways

If you want to film in public spaces in Lincolnshire and will not be requiring traffic restrictions or causing and obstruction to pedestrians, you do not need a permit.

If your filming requires traffic restrictions such as [temporary traffic restrictions](#) or [parking suspensions](#), our highways teams are happy to discuss this process and will expedited the required notification period if possible.

Type of Order	Cost
TTRO less than five days duration	£1,048 (£948 if online payment method chosen)
TTRO greater than five days duration	£1,146 (£1,046 if online payment method chosen)
Emergency TTRO	£671 (£571 if online payment method chosen)
Amendment, cancellation or extension	£743
Amended invoice administration fee	£120
